Shirley Dunkle and her husband, William, were residents of West Falmouth who organized and indexed the Bowerman-Gifford family papers located at the West Falmouth Library.

Scope and Content Note

The papers date from 1900 to 1998 and contain notes prepared by William and Shirley Dunkle in the process of organizing and indexing the Bowerman-Gifford family papers at the West Falmouth Library. Items include budgets, reports, and a copy of the completed index of the collection.

In addition, the papers contain a copy of "William Swyft of Sandwitch," a genealogy. There is also a copy of the index for the book, prepared by Elisabeth Stewart in 1992.
