Biographical and Historical Information

Brian Tucholke served on the West Falmouth Library Board of Directors from 2013 to 2017.

The West Falmouth Library was founded in 1893, and the current library building was built and dedicated in 1896. The land was donated by R. J. and Abby (Grant) Mendenhall.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of a shadow box, which contains metal objects found by Brian Tucholke while metal detecting on the grounds of the West Falmouth Library. Items include coins, buttons, keys, nails and bolts, and other various metal pieces. The dates of most of the objects are unknown.

Brian Tucholke originally gave the collection to the Library around 2013, when it was put on display. He formally donated the shadow box to the Archives with a deed of gift on October 8, 2016 (acc. 2016-12).
